2012 Sonoma County Pinot Grigio

Vineyard

Mononi Ranch, Russian River Valley. A gorgeous vineyard in the heart of one of Sonoma Counties best growing regions.

Production

The grapes were hand picked and fermented in Napa Valley, California. After destemming, and a gentle press, the juice was then settled at cold temperatures for 24 hours and transferred to a stainless steel tank for fermentation. The cool fermentation temperatures allows for accentuation of the fruity aromas. After transportation to our Connecticut winery, the wine was aged in stainless steel tanks to retain the bright varietal characteristics.
